

COURSE INTRODUCTION

The Dangerous Goods Regulations UN staff Category 8 Awareness Course seeks to provide the participants with the knowledge of the applicable rules and procedures, in the correct handling of various forms of hazardous materials according to prevailing national and international industry standard. The program meets the requirements of the UAE Civil Aviation Regulations.

ACCREDITATION

The course is approved & accredited by General Civil Aviation Authority (GCAA) of the United Arab Emirates.

AUDIENCE/MINIMUM QUALIFICATION

This program is designed for airside ramp supervisors of attendants and porters who need to instruct and monitor the loading staff as to the correct loading position of certain types of dangerous goods, warehouse personnel responsible for the storage of goods, handling import and export cargo, mail, and stores. Good in English (reading, writing, speaking)

- Overview of the roles of the airlines, cargo agents, Airports, and ground handling agents,
- Limitations and Prohibitions for carriage by aircraft crew members and passengers in baggage, and in commercial quantities of cargo shipments
- Definition and Description, Hazard Classes, Divisions, and Compatibility Groups
- Identification by Proper Shipping Name and by UN or ID Number
- Packaging, Marking and labeling requirements
- Warehouse storage and compatibility requirements

- Aircraft stowage and cargo aircraft only requirements Pilot notification, use of the NOTOC on a flight
- Emergency response guidelines for DG Incidents or Accidents, and reporting requirements
